With such subtle good news on the ground these days, it's nice to find a positive piece of economic data. You would think there would be cheering in the corridors, but there is no more there should certainly be. The good news is for companies owned by women. There are about 6 million women-owned businesses in the United States. Every day, 400 new ones are launched, representing about 55% of new startups; whatever the economic climate, women have certainly not lost their courage. More surprising, however, is their success: women's businesses are experiencing an 11% growth rate (compared to 6% in other companies) employment growth of 18% (compared to 8%) and revenue growth of 32% (compared to 24% in other companies). Even more surprising is the success of businesses that are owned by black women: they are growing at twice the rate of all female-owned businesses and four times the rate of all U.S. businesses. Forgive the outbreak of italics, but these are really impressive numbers. What does it mean? Given that female-owned businesses receive only about 10% of all risk funding, it certainly tells us something about money. These companies do more with less. Many of them have what is politely called a greater number of sources of funding using a wider range of financial products. In other words, they find financing from all over the place - commercial bank loans, supplier credit, family funds and credit cards. Risk funds are so predominantly male, and their culture so macho, that many women don't even attempt this route - and some see a real advantage in bootstrap. Kimberly Bunting, CEO of Business Access, started her company with the help of friends, family and banks - and thinks this thinness has given her business a cultural advantage. Prudence and thrift are intertwined in every aspect of business operations. Quality assurance is not a watchword, it is a financial reality, says Bunting. When our revenues are effective, our expenses follow. We have real pain when we make the wrong decisions. These skills will be valuable to our company for all our years to come. But it also points out that a certain amount of work for Business Access is committed to the cause - in this case, the cause of building software systems that help disabled people find work. This sense of mission does not shift business objectives; the company has doubled every year. The meaning of the mission is how that growth is accomplished. Employees don't feel like they're just making money, they're also making a difference. Although this is not true for every single female-owned company, I am struck that it is characteristic of many, and of those of greater The data show that women-owned enterprises also have other interesting characteristics: they are more likely to offer flexible working hours; are more involved in community activity and offer more free time for employee community engagements. Their recruitment is diverse (women do not only hire women) and they are also more likely to offer a choice of and retirement plans. Doing good and doing well are inextricably linked. These opportunities are not a cost; are a benefit. The corporate world always learns from entrepreneurs, and there's a lot to learn here. Especially since many of the women who start these big businesses are leaving big companies to do so. They are sick and tired of being belittled, mistreated, harassed, underpaid and underpromoted. They do not leave to have children and bake cookies, but to pursue opportunities that will prove more challenging and to build companies that are more respectful of humans. The increased success of female-owned enterprises completely challenges female stereotypes. They are tech experts, they make great use of formal consultants (not just networks of old guys) and they're not just going into the service industry - but under construction, transportation, communication and public services. These high-level business women are at risk and taking risks without much support from the investment community at a time of economic uncertainty. Can you imagine what they could do in good times, with real support? Of course not all companies owned by a woman are a comparison and, like all startups, many fail. But there is much to learn from the phenomena of female-owned enterprises. What I get out of it is the value of taking risks (maybe that safe work with the safe company isn't so safe after all) and the value of the purpose. Women - and women of color - are succeeding because they are so driven - not only to succeed, but to succeed with their own lights, according to their own values. Rather than seeking certainty and balance in my next career move, maybe I should look for mission, commitment and boldness. And, of course, for women. While most shooters have a predominantly male user base, Overwatch has attracted a large female following due to its focus on characters and additional material such as animated short films, comics, and even Funko Pop figures.
